PRO-INDEPENDENCE ACTIVITIES

I am asking you to actively support the principles of freedom and democracy by helping the Lithuanian people. Here's what you can do:

- 1) Keep informed about current developments in the Republic of Lithuania by monitoring the stories and articles published in newspapers and magazines and broadcast over the television and radio.
- 2) Write letters to publications that print reader's opinions so that as many people as possible will become aware of this latest threat to world freedom from the Soviets.
- 3) Express your opinions to President Bush as he directs the foreign policy in the United States.
- a) After reviewing the previous day's developments, call the White House comments line at (202) 456-7639. You will be able to state your opinion to an operator. Your comments will be forwarded to the President on a daily basis. You can call as often as you wish, even daily. The comments line office is open 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Eastern time, Monday through Friday. Because of the time difference, be sure to call before 3:00 p.m. Denver time.
- b) Send a pre-written telegram by calling Western Union at 1-800-257-4900 and asking for hotline operator 9654. A message is on file. It is updated and revised on a regular basis. Currently it reads:

Mr. President, we urge you to grant recognition to the government of independent Lithuania and to request President Gorbachev not to interfere in its internal affairs.

The first telegram is \$5.75 and additional telegrams cost \$5.00 each.

- 4) Express your opinion to your Senators and Representatives in Washington. They will be considering such measures as ratification of arms limitations treaties, trade concessions to the Soviets and most favored nation status for the Soviet Union and will be able to influence the planned super power summit this summer.
- a) Call and write using the list of names, addresses and telephone numbers attached.
 - b) Send the above-mentioned telegram.
- 5) Sign and collect names on petitions that express your opinion. We will be sending you petition forms.
